Player, Parent, & Spectator Code of Conduct

THE PLAYER WILL:

* Make every effort to develop their own sporting abilities, in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina by attending all practice sessions and games.

* Give maximum effort and attention striving for the best possible performance during a games and training sessions.

- * Set a positive example for others in the community and their teammates.
- * Avoid all forms of gamesmanship, and time wasting during games.
- * Not use inappropriate language at any time
- * To promote and follow Fair Play and the Laws of the Game.
- * Know and abide by the Laws, rules and spirit of the game, and the competition rules.
- * Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.
- * Resist any temptation to take banned substances such as alcohol or drugs.
- * Treat opponents with due respect at all times, irrespective of the result of the game.

* Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence and rough play, and offer due care and attention towards injured opponents.

- * Show Respect towards the Match Officials
- * Accept the decision of the Match Official without any protest.
- * Show due respect towards Team Officials of both teams.

* Abide by the instructions of their Coach and Team Officials, provided they do not contradict the spirit of this Code.

THE PARENTS AND SPECTATORS WILL:

* Not demonstrate negative attitudes which have a significant bearing on a child's attitude towards other players, league officers, referees, managers, or spectators.

* Always be positive and encouraging towards all of the children not just their own.

* Ensure the maximum attendance to all training sessions and games for their child. (Should unforeseen circumstances arise please contact the coach directly to inform of any absence.)

- * Applaud the opposition as well as your own team.
- * Avoid coaching the child during the game or training session at any time
- * Not shout and scream at any point during the game.
- * Respect the referee's decision at all times
- * Give attention to each of the children involved in football not just the most talented.
- * Give encouragement to everyone to participate in football.

Parent support is crucial to the running of our club and providing the best possible soccer experience for your child. By signing this agreement, we ask for your support in running the club in the best possible interests of player development and setting an example of behavior to all those involved within our club.

The Coach will be open to communication with you on matters relating to the team and your child. They will inform you of training, game and tournament times and dates. Team selection, tactics and game time will be at the sole discretion of the coach and we ask that you support these decisions and the position for which they have given their time to fulfill.
